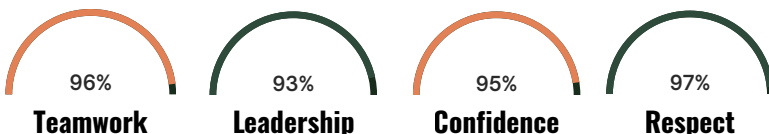

For 35 years, with your help, we have led youth to a better path, and this year, that path led us to some truly remarkable milestones:

The Strength of Our Reach

Growth is not just about numbers, but the lives behind them. Over the past four years, Camptown has had the privilege of serving over 20,000 youth. Last year alone, we saw that impact come to life through:

- **Epic IPS Middle School Expeditions:** Our partnership with Indianapolis Public Schools took students to the breathtaking New River Gorge, where many experienced the thrill of whitewater and the vastness of the wilderness for the very first time.
- **Youth Leader Adventures:** Our dedicated Youth Leaders pushed their limits at Pictured Rocks, Michigan, navigating the rugged beauty of the Upper Peninsula and returning with a renewed sense of resilience and leadership.
- **Expanding Our Support:** We successfully expanded our Flourishing Families and HopeTrails programs, reaching deeper into the community to support those who can benefit from restoration and healing.

Transformation That Matters

While the landscapes we visit are grand, the most significant changes happen on a personal scale. This year, we followed the journey of a young man who entered our program testing at a high risk for suicide. Through the intentional mentorship and carefully planned adventures, he completed the program testing at a low risk. This is why we do what we do. Beyond hiking the trail, we are providing the space for kids to rediscover their own worth and hope.

A New Horizon

Perhaps the most visible change of 2025 is the one right here at home. This year, Camptown moved into a new space. This move is the foundation for our next chapter. We are currently developing plans for an even greater expanded impact that will allow us to serve our community in ways we've only dreamed of.
